GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

Paper submission can be made only through email. All submitted papers will be reviewed by a panel of experts, and accepted papers will be published in the conference edited book with ISBN. Authors are requested to send their manuscripts to conference.lpf@gmail.com

Submission Guidelines:

- Paper length should be 2500–4000 words.
- Authors must provide Title (Dr./Mr./Ms./Mrs.), Full Name, Affiliation, and Email Address.
- Include an Abstract (maximum 200 words) at the beginning of the paper.
- References should follow APA style.
- Font: Times New Roman, 12-point size. Line spacing: Single.
- Plagiarism level should be below 15%, and AI-generated content should not exceed 30%.
- The last date of paper submission is **20 April 2026**.
